

WOODBURY'S 2026 EARTH DAY ECO-WARRIOR AWARD EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Eco-Warrior Award was established in 2024 to celebrate the individuals who help shape a more sustainable future for our community. If you know someone making a difference, we encourage you to submit a nomination and help us recognize their impact.

Nominees are evaluated based on one or more of the following areas:

Environmental Impact:

Demonstrated meaningful, hands-on efforts to protect or improve the environment. This may include conservation, waste reduction, recycling or composting initiatives, habitat restoration, water or land protection, or sustainable practices that produced visible or lasting results.

Leadership & Initiative:

Evidence of initiative beyond personal responsibility. Nominees may have led projects, organized activities, or inspired others through advocacy, innovation, or example.

Consistency & Commitment:

Recognition of sustained dedication rather than one-time actions. Nominees should reflect ongoing environmental responsibility or leadership over time.

Education & Awareness:

Contributions that increased environmental understanding or encouraged responsible choices through outreach, mentoring, programming, or community engagement.

Connection to Woodbury and Surrounding Areas:

A clear benefit or connection to Woodbury, even if the nominee's work extends into surrounding areas. Efforts should positively influence the local community, environment, or regional ecosystem.
